

REACH Compliance Statement

REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals) is a European Union Commission (EUC) Regulation on chemicals and their safe use (EC 1907/2006) entered force on 01 June, 2007.

Safeplast Oy supports the basic aim of REACH in improving the protection of human health and environment through the better and earlier identification of intrinsic properties of chemical substances. Safeplast Oy meets all applicable REACH requirements and is committed to provide our customers with information about substances in our products as required.

REACH requires actors in the supply chain to identify the presence of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) that are published in the Candidate List. We review the (SVHC's) list on regular basis and in accordance with Article 33 of REACH, communicate the presence of any Candidate List substances present in the product at a concentration of >0.1% by weight.

Under REACH, registration of substances which are used in the manufacturing of articles do not apply to Safeplast operation. We are a downstream user (any natural or legal person established within the Community, other than the manufacturer or the importer, who uses a substance, either on its own or in a preparation, in the course of his industrial or professional activities) as a "Producer of articles". Downstream users of substances generally do not have registration obligations.

Safeplast Oy products are "articles" as defined in REACH Article 3(3) and do not release substances under their normal use.

Safeplast Oy products do not contain substances that would exceed defined limits of the chemicals currently listed SVHC's. Safeplast Oy will continue to work with our suppliers to ensure that all SVHC's are notified to the European Chemicals Agency, if necessary, to comply with the REACH requirement.

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
